Documents and details Required for Architecture Team Review.

Required Documents

1. Completed Form for Fenced Garden on website, then save to your computer.

You must include:

- a. Material and color for fence posts and rails (wood is recommended)
- b. Size, type, and color of wire mesh.
- c. Height of fencing
- d. Fenced garden dimensions
- e. Material used for raised bed and color

2. Diagram showing:

- a. Placement of the garden in relationship to house, property lines and roads.
- b. Approximate distance of garden from property lines, roads and utility easement.
- c. Orientation (which way is north).
- d. A picture of the intended finished garden is helpful.

Summary of the relevant rules in CC&Rs, Architecture Guidelines, and Rules and Regulations. You are expected to review these documents for additional details.

Raised gardens and garden fencing are an exception to general garden fencing when the fenced area is less than 144 sq ft.

- Fine mesh screening may be used to keep birds and small animals out (See Architectural Guidelines, and Rules and Regulations for details)
- May be up to a height of 8 feet, however, for the area above 5 feet, light weight material should be used to minimize visual impact
- Must be in back yard and hidden from view to the extent reasonable for the lot.
- All other general fencing rules apply.
